DECREE OF THE MINISTER OF MINES AND ENERGY NUMBER 134.K/201/M.PE/1996 CONCERNING THE USE OF MAPS AND CLARIFICATION OF BOUNDARIES AND EXTENT OF THE AREAS OF MINING CONCESSIONS, WORK CONTRACTS AND COAL WORK CONTRACTS IN THE GENERAL MINING AREA

THE MINISTER OF MINES AND ENERGY

- Considering : a. that in the framework of improving mining business services and with a view to better expediting the process of application for Mining Concessions (KP), Work Contracts (KK) and Coal Work Contracts (KKB), it is necessary to have uniformity in the use of maps and the clarification of boundaries and extent of mining areas;
 - b. that in connection with the above-mentioned matter, it is deemed necessary to review the Instruction of the Minister of Mines and Energy No. 08.1/201/M.PE/1984 dated August 4.
- In view of : 1. Law No 11/1967 (State Gazette of 1967 No. 22, Additional State Gazette No. 2831);
 - Government Regulation No. 32/1969 (State Gazette of 1969 No. 60, Additional State Gazette No. 2916) as already amended by Government Regulation No. 79/1992;
 - Government Regulation No. 27/1980 (State Gazette of 1980 No. 47, Additional State Gazette No. 3174);
 - 4. Presidential Decree No. 96/M/1993 dated March 17, 1993;
 - 5. Decree of the Minister of Mines and Energy No. 2027.K/201/M.PE/1985 dated September 19,1985;
 - 6. Decree of the Minister of Mines and Energy No. 846.K/20/M.PE/1986 dated August 9, 1986.

HAS DECIDED:

- By revoking : the Instruction of the Minister of Mines and Energy No. 08.1/201/M.PE/1984 dated August 4, 1984.
- To stipulate : DECREE OF THE MINISTER OF MINES AND ENERGY CONCERNING THE USE OF MAPS AND CLARIFICATION OF BOUNDARIES AND EXTENT OF THE AREAS OF MINING CONCESSIONS, WORK CONTRACTS AND COAL WORK CONTRACTS IN THE GENERAL MINING AREA

Article 1

The basic map for testing used in the general mining business activities must be based on the topography map issued by the National Coordinating Agency for Surveys and Mapping (Bakosurtanal) of 1981 and or by the Directorate Topography of the Army of 1978 with the scale of 1: 250,000, with the exception of Sulawesi with the scale of 1: 200,000.

Article 2

- (1) Every application for Mining Concessions, Work Contracts and Coal Work Contracts shall be obligated to use the area map as meant in Article 1.
- (2) It is obligatory that the areas for Mining Concessions, Work Contracts and Coal Work Contracts should have as their boundaries lines parallel to the latitude and the longitude in the geographical coordinate system, lapping over the latitude and the longitude with the multiplication of half a minute (30").
- (3) The list of the coordinates of the points making up area boundaries as meant in paragraph (2) must be attached to the area map when the application is filed.

Article 3

The extent of the area applied for shall be stipulated as follows:

- a. 25,000 (twenty-five thousand) hectares for Mining Concessions for General Surveys and 10,000 (ten thousand) hectares for Mining Concessions for Explorations;
- b. Not more than 250,000 (two hundred and fifty thousand) hectares for Work Contracts;
- c. Not more than 100,000 (a hundred) hectares for Coal Work Contracts.

Article 4

- (1) The Director General may approve of an application for the extent for an area of Mining Concessions exceeding the stipulation as meant in Article 3 if on the basis of technical and economic evaluation greater benefits may be obtained and the development of the said area may be sped up.
- (2) The Director General shall be obligated to submit reports to the Minister on the approval of applications for the extent of areas of Mining Concessions as meant in paragraph (1).

Article 5

Changes in the boundaries and extent of the areas for Mining Concessions, Work Contracts and Coal Work Contracts made after the stipulation of this Ministerial Decree shall be adjusted to the stipulation in Article 2 paragraph (2) of this Ministerial Decree.

Article 6

Enforcement stipulations of this Ministerial Decree shall be laid down by the Director General of General Mining.

Article 7

The use of maps and clarification of boundaries and extent of the areas for Mining Concessions, Work Contracts and Coal Work Contracts prior to the stipulation of this Ministerial Decree shall have to conform to the stipulation of this Ministerial Decree.

Article 8

This Ministerial Decree shall take effect as from the date of stipulation.
